DAY 1

Hemingways Nairobi - Bed & Breakfast

DAY 2

Nairobi to Loisaba Conservancy - 1 Hour Flight
Loisaba Star Beds - Full Board (Breakfast, Lunch & Dinner)

After breakfast, transfer to Wilson airport for your scheduled flight to Loisaba Conservancy. A 57,000 acre wildlife conservancy located in Laikipia, Northern Kenya. With abundant wildlife, exquisite accommodation and adventurous activities, Loisaba will revive your mind, rejuvenate your body and revitalize your soul.

After a one-hour flight you will land in the middle of the conservancy, the Loisaba Camp Team welcoming you at the airstrip. You will board your safari vehicles to be transferred to Loisaba Star Beds, with your first game drive en-route. Arrival at the Camp in time for your lunch.

Loisaba Star Beds - Poised on a rocky kopje, the Loisaba Star Beds command sweeping views over an undulating valley and a permanent waterhole, frequented by resident wildlife. Handcrafted four-poster wooden beds sit on raised wooden platforms jutting out from a thatched-roof accommodation and are rolled out each night for guests to enjoy the most memorable sleep under the endless African sky.



Rustically designed to complement the surrounding environment, each star bed is individually built in harmony with the natural rocky features, incorporating a sitting area, and open plan bathroom with a view. A team of traditional Samburu & Laikipiak Maasai warriors welcome and host you with their customary warm African hospitality. Rising early to watch sunrise from your Star Bed with a comforting hot beverage, the day ahead promises adventure, with a myriad of activities by which to experience Loisaba. A day of fun is rounded off with drinks by the log fire in the Star Beds lounge, sharing tall tales of the African bush, with the tale-telling continuing over a delicious shared dinner. Loisaba Star Beds is a truly authentic and intimate African experience.

Loisaba is made for adventure: guests enjoy complete freedom to choose how they spend their time so the only barrier is your own imagination. Trek through the bush with camels, mountain bike down the escarpment, horseback-ride or drive through the wild canyons of the two great rivers that span the vast property.

Afternoon game drive. Sundowner before driving back to the camp for dinner and overnight. Your stay at Loisaba Star Beds is for 2 nights, and is on all-inclusive basis (all meals and drinks (excluding champagne, private cellar wines and spirits), shared and scheduled game drives, guided walking safari, sundowners and transfers to and from our designated airstrips and laundry).



DAY 3

Loisaba Conservancy

Loisaba Star Beds - Full Board

Full day of activities in Loisaba including Early morning walking safari, game drives, sundowners, dinner and overnight at the Camp.

DAY 4

Loisaba Conservancy to Masai Mara - 1 Hour Flight

Mara Ngenche Safari Camp - Full Board

Following breakfast, you have a shared morning game drive and transfer to the airstrip for your scheduled flight to Masai Mara. You are met on arrival by the camp's vehicle and provided a shared game drive en route to the camp arriving in time for lunch at Mara Ngenche Safari Camp. After some time to enjoy the camp's facilities, you have a shared afternoon game drive ending with sundowners in the bush. Then return to the camp for dinner and overnight.



Accommodation Mara Ngenche Safari Camp is on full board basis including all meals, bottled water, juice, local beer, house wine by the glass and nonpremium spirits.

Mara Ngenche Safari Camp - In a spectacular location in the heart of the Masai Mara, lies this small, intimate, luxurious and elegant Camp. Well hidden in the beautiful panorama of ravine forest, Mara Ngenche Safari Camp offers Superb views over the confluence of the Mara and Talek Rivers Overlooking a hippo pool that is always busy with these beautiful Large animals with crocodiles always in close proximity. The incredible surroundings of the Maasai Mara makes this a spectacular safari experience. Game drives are always thrilling and are guided by qualified expert local Maasai guides in open-sided 4WDs, (with a maximum of six guest per vehicle). Mara Ngenche Safari Camp is unfenced and is designed to allow the exciting movement of animals through the grounds offering an elegant yet relaxed atmosphere for experiencing the full adventure of the African bush. In addition each tent has its own private plunge pool.

Afternoon game drive. Maasai Mara is a magnificent landscape of open plains bisected by the Mara River and its tributaries and punctuated by marshes and forests. Certainly the most frequented game reserve in Kenya, this 650 sq kilometer reserve supports the highest density of game to be seen anywhere.



DAY 5

Maasai Mara

Mara Ngenche Safari Camp - Full Board

Following an early breakfast at the camp, you depart for a full day of shared game viewing in Masai Mara National Reserve. A picnic lunch is served in the bush.

The Masai Mara Game Reserve is often called simply “The Mara” - a Masai word meaning “mottled” - a reference to its patchy landscape. During the seasonal migrations, Maasai Mara is home to up to a million wildebeest and an equally impressive number of zebras that move into the area from neighboring Serengeti National Park, in Tanzania. The reserve is home to all the “big five” and it is also possible to observe; baboon, eland, ostrich, bat-eared fox, jackal and cheetah. The rivers abound with hippos and crocodiles. Maasai Mara topography creates a unique bio-diverse area, providing guests with the opportunity to venture into the savanna covered with hundreds or even thousands of animals of many different species.



DAY 6

Maasai Mara

Mara Ngenche Safari Camp - Full Board

We continue to explore this miraculous area on our morning and afternoon game drives. Optional Activities include Bush Breakfast/Dinner, Visit to the Maasai Village, Balloon Safari.

The gentle ride of the Balloon Safari is nearly two hours of watching zebras galloping across the plains, lions hunting down wildebeests, and so much more. Upon landing, you will be surprised by champagne and a hot gourmet breakfast spread out before you. You enjoy a farewell dinner under the stars and overnight at the camp.



DAY 7

Maasai Mara to Nairobi - 1 Hour Flight Return / Departure

Following breakfast, say 'Kwaheri' - a Swahili word for bye to Masai Mara and you transfer to the airstrip for your flight back to Nairobi's Wilson Airport. You are met on arrival and transfer to Hemingways Nairobi where you have use of a day room. In the evening transfer to carnivore restaurant for dinner.

The Carnivore is considered 'Africa's Greatest Eating Experience'. A variety of meats including a selection of exotic meat is roasted over charcoal and carved at your table on traditional Maasai swords (skewers). Delicious side dishes and an exceptional array of sauces complement this fixed price feast that also includes soup, a selection of desserts and Kenyan coffee.

Set in attractive tropical gardens, the service and the décor are outstanding. After dinner transfer to the airport for your international flight home your Safari ends here.
