



DAY TRIP TO LAKE NAKURU NATIONAL PARK

Located just a 2-3hr drive from Nairobi, Lake Nakuru National Park is the perfect choice for those wanting a safari when time is limited. Once home to Kenya's famous flamingo flocks, the park is now most famous for its large herds of buffalo, the presence of four of the Big Five, and its large population of rhinoceros. The Safari departs in the early morning. Along the way you have the chance to stop at a viewpoint and take pictures of the Great Rift Valley below you. The day is spent game viewing within the park; stopping for a lunch at one of the lodges in the Park. The nearby cliffs offer sightings of baboons, birds of prey and scurrying hyraxes, as well as great views of the park. Lake Nakuru National Park covers 180 square km and is home to warthogs, waterbuck, buffaloes, reedbucks, leopards as well as White and Black Rhinos. We return to Nairobi in the late afternoon. You may get out of the vehicle at the Lake shore to get a closer look at the birds.

Lake Nakuru Day Trip Summary Itinerary

0600 Hours: Pick-up from your residence/ Hotel

0700 Hours: Depart Nairobi for Nakuru National Park

1000 Hours: Arrive at the Nakuru National Park and proceed for a two hour game drive

1230 Hours: Enjoy lunch at the Sarova Lion hill Lodge or Lake Nakuru Lodge

1400 Hours: Depart for a game drive

1600 Hours: Depart for Nairobi by Road

1900 Hours: Nairobi arrival and transfer to your residence/ Hotel
